### ***Did you know??***

- No sting barrier is not a 'tactifier'
- Alcohol free—comfortable even on damaged skin
- Will not interfere with healing if skin is damaged
- Protective coating between the skin and the adhesive
- Skin damage can lead to increased risk of colonization and infection
- When the dressing is changed, barrier film is removed instead of skin cell layers

### **Tips for Application:**

- Remove old dressing
- Apply antiseptic prep—allow to dry. ⌚
- Apply no-sting barrier film
  - Avoid insertion site and area of CHG sponge
  - Coat the area that will be covered by the dressing
- *Important--*Allow barrier film to dry *completely*. ⌚
- Apply CHG sponge
- Apply new dressing
