## Use Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) Scrub

## CHG is a powerful ally in CLABSI Prevention

- 1. Use alcohol to clean all visible gunk at the site
- 2. When things "look" clean, use CHG on every square millimeter of skin, catheter and sutures/stabilizing device.
  - Use back and forth scrubbing –friction is needed
  - Cover the area with CHG completely
  - Scrub for 30 full seconds (Silently hum the Happy Birthday song 3 times!)
- 3. CHG must then "air dry" before dressing placement

Key Point: do not use anything to clean after CHG or wipe off with gauze

CHG will CONTINUE killing microbes for several days (and that is super powerful)!
