

Sepsis Narrator Introduction

3 Hour Bundle

Obtain a STAT Lactate Level

Get Blood Cultures prior to antibiotics

Administer Broad Spectrum Antibiotic

IV crystalloid fluid bolus-30cc/kg for lactate ≥4 or hypotension

6 Hour Bundle

Repeat Lactate if initial was >2

Check 2 BP's within 1 hour after fluids are completed


Apply vasopressors for persistent hypotension

Clinician reassesses patient and documents a 'Reassessment Note' for Septic Shock

- Sepsis is a medical emergency and the leading cause of death in U.S. Hospitals.
- Early recognition and early intervention through a bundled care approach has been proven to save lives.
- The sepsis narrator is a tool within Epic that guides the healthcare team in the delivery of excellent sepsis care within timing specified in the bundles.
- Use the narrator to help ensure these 3 and 6-hour bundle elements are completed and improve outcomes for our patients with sepsis.


Initiating Code Sepsis

The RN should open the Sepsis Narrator when a Code Sepsis is initiated. That RN should document the Start of the Event by selecting Accept on Sepsis Documentation Start.




Opening the Checklist

Next the RN will select Checklist to open the Sepsis Checklist on the right side of the screen.



Closing/Collapsing the Checklist


The Checklist will remain open in all activities on the sidebar until the end of the Code Sepsis documentation. Or, unless manually collapsed by using the blue arrow.




Time Since Sepsis Call

Timers have been created to easily note the time that has passed since the Code Sepsis was called.

Documenting Staff Involved

When a Code Sepsis is initiated, the RN should document team members that are present. In initial huddle click Yes (Add Staff Who Attended Huddle) hyperlink and in the pop-up window select the staff members that attended the Code Sepsis Huddle.



Viewing the Checklist

Within the Checklist, items required are separated into their time bundles (0-3 HR, 3-6 HR). The RN will work together with the Provider to complete the required documentation items.









When labs, such as lactate and blood cultures are collected from the Narrator, select Save and New on the Sepsis Checklist and those rows will turn green, indicating this task has been completed.


Note: If a patient's first lactate is > 2, a repeat lactate is required, a red alert will notify the team.





When the antibiotics and/or sepsis fluid bolus are administered from the MAR, click Save and New in the Sepsis Checklist to turn the task green indicating this tasks has been completed.

Reminder: The Sepsis fluid bolus is dependent on the use of the 30cc/kg fluid bolus order located on the Sepsis QuickList, if the order is not utilized, the nurse may manually insert the time the IVF was started and stopped.



Two blood pressures are required within an hour of the bolus stop time. Add these BP's from either the ED Alert:




Or the hyperlink within the Sepsis Checklist:


2 BP's required within one hour of bolus stop time. If one or both BP's are low, repeat BP. If patient remains hypotensive, notify provider.

BP # 2
BP # 3


If the patient is hypotensive a red alert will appear, repeat the BP, if the patient remains hypotensive, the patient may require a vasopressor, if the vasopressor is ordered the vasopressor row will automatically turn green.



Don't Forget! When documenting the elements of the bundle the RN should click Save and New button to update the checklist



If at anytime, the time field disappears, use the time convention and type "n" to enter the current time.




Patients with septic shock require a sepsis reassessment note to be completed by the provider, when the Provider completes the note, the row will automatically turn green. There are options to manually complete this row, such as N/A for patients with sepsis/severe sepsis.

Sepsis Documentation End

When all "required" 3 and 6 hour bundle elements are completed, the Sepsis Narrator, should be ended. At the end of the checklist, select Sepsis Documentation End and Save and New.





Sepsis Narrator Documentation Reminders

- Code Sepsis documentation travels with the patient. The next nurse or team can open the sepsis narrator and quickly see what has been done and what may still be required.
- Utilizing the Enhanced Sepsis Narrator checklist will help ensure that the care needed for patients with sepsis is delivered in the recommended timing that is critical to improving outcomes.
