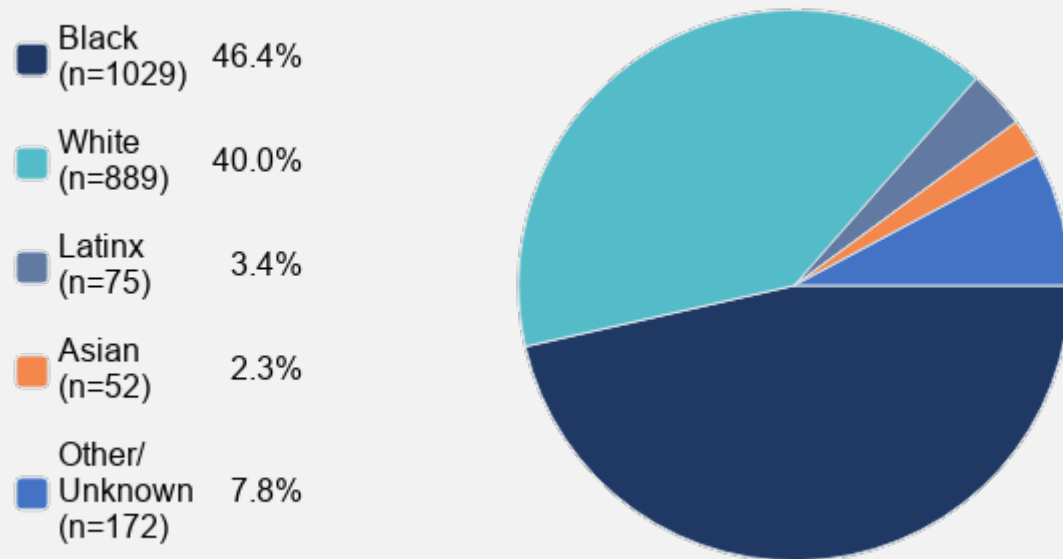


# Race, Ethnicity, and 60-day Outcomes After Hospitalization with COVID-19





Results from 38 Michigan hospitals participating in joint CQI effort from 3/16/20-7/1/20

## COVID-19 Positive Patients (n=2217)




## Patient Outcomes After Hospitalization

Black patients (n=65, 60.2%):

- lowest physician follow-up 
- longest delays in returning to work (avg. 35.5 days) 

Non-white patients (n=144, 55%):

- readmitted to hospital within 60 days 

White patients (n=153, 21.5%):

- death post-discharge 

Post-discharge care coordination is critical to reducing poor health outcomes following a COVID-19 related hospitalization
